

## Using the Dragon Recorder app on iPhone or iPad — transfer audio files to your computer via Wi-Fi

1. Download the Dragon Recorder app from the App Store (this app is free)
2. Tap to record / Tap again to pause /Double To end recording
3. Click on Recordings to see the list of recordings
4. click on the blue arrow to the right of the recording to rename

### Transfer audio files to your computer via Wi-Fi

In Dragon Recorder app Options, turn Wi-Fi sharing On

The instructions say — with a Bonjour enabled browser, connect to your phone on the local network (I haven't tried this yet)

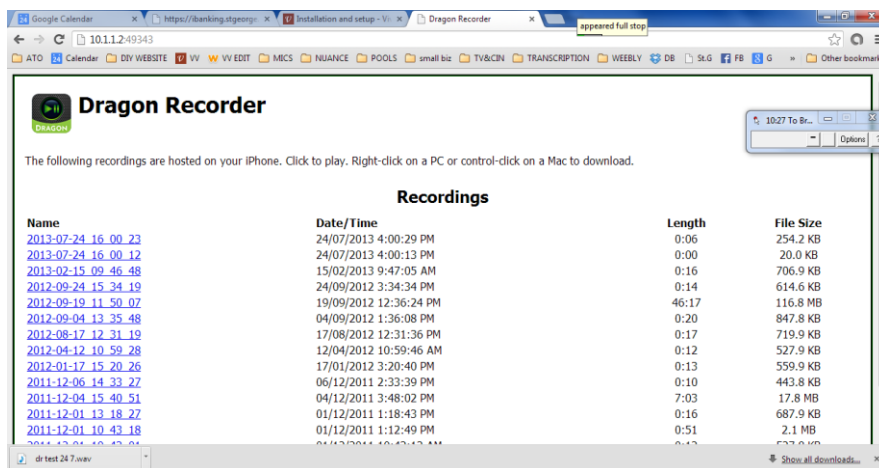
Alternatively, in any other web browser, navigate to: <http://10.1.2:49343>

That is, copy and paste this URL into your web browser, then Press Enter — I tried this and it worked.

A list of my recordings appeared.

Right click on the recording you want to transcribe, then/Save link as, browse to the folder where you want to save the audio file.

Next step is to use Dragon NaturallySpeaking to transcribe.



### Tip

Create a vocabulary shortcut or text macro for the URL <http://10.1.2:49343>

You could then say “Insert speech file URL” or something similar as the spoken form.

To create a vocabulary shortcut, say “Edit vocabulary” copy and paste the URL into the Written form field, and type in or dictate a Spoken form. Say “Click add” / “Close”
